Hi reps,

We are just a month away from the amazing event in the history of the International ATC tournament.

I hope the visa process has not annoyed and frustrated you too much and has not given you a reason to change your mind about coming. This is just a small obstacle to achieve the great goal of uniting peoples and I'm grateful to hockey for helping us do it. The small thing left is transportation, we want to remind you that we will provide transportation for all our guests. We don't want to lose any of our participants and that's why we are asking the captains to fill in the transportation spreadsheet s. We've sent the spreadsheet to each captain and if you haven't received it, write me asap to let me know. We decided to make the chart thus because many captains have forgotten their passwords, others complained about the inconvenience of using the page. However, to avoid more work, we've downloaded all the information that some captains have partially filled into their roster onto a spreadsheet and given them the ability to complete their chart themselves. Moreover, in order to avoid confusion, we've made two charts, one for Moscow and the other for St. Petersburg. The Captains whose participants are staying in Moscow need to fill in the chart on arrival in Moscow, departure from Moscow we fill ourselves so we have provisionally reserved the tickets for all participants who will be in Moscow.

If can't do it asap we would be unable to pick up you at the airports and as a result of getting to the hotels by yourself!

The price of a train ticket from Moscow to St. Petersburg by fast train will be around \$ 50, I'll find out the schedule on Monday and will tell you. I can remind you that the sightseeing tour in Moscow will be on Sunday. A few participants want to leave Moscow on April 1 after the tour, so we've reserved an evening train for them. I also want to note that accommodation will be in the Standard rooms at the Marriott as they are just as good as the Superior rooms, for which they didn't offer us a competitive rate. In any case, there's very little difference between them so please don't worry about that.
